DECIDACTION



DECIDACTION is a springboard for the dreams and projects of young individuals from First Nations. More specifically, it's a participatory youth budgeting pilot initiative for First Nations youth aged 12 to 35. During the week of week of October 23rd, DECIDACTION involved young people aged 12 to 35 from Kiuna, Gespeg, and Wendake. After reviewing the applications, a random draw was conducted. Two communities, Wendake and Gespeg, were selected, sparking great pride and motivation among the young individuals who submitted the projects.

A "lac-à-l'épaule" retreat

As part of an organizational development approach, the FNS team initiated a "Lac-à-l'épaule" to gather the voices of the youth, understand their needs, and assess the existing ecosystem. This retreat strengthened group cohesion, encouraged collective intelligence, and led to concrete actions promoting inclusive collaboration. As a result, the team emerged with a multitude of ideas as well as a shared vision for the future.
