Currently, we have officially confirmed visits to Uashat mak Mani-Utenam and Kawawachikamach with the Grand Portage camps. These week-long camps enable high school students to contribute to a 2 km trail in the forest, fostering a sense of connection to the land, teamwork and pride in contributing to the well-being of their community.
