## DID YOU KNOW...

Every bag of herbal tea sold at the Hôtel-Musée Premières Nations contributes directly to our cause? Each variety has been carefully named after the season it represents in the Wendat language:

- "ohcha' hiver" (balsam fir, sage, juniper, marigold petals)
- "yänenda'yeh autumn" (agastache, hyssop, birch, calendula petals, sumac)
- "yayenna' summer" (cornflower green tea, cornflowers, hawthorn, cornflower centaury)
- "yayenra' spring" (Labrador tea, peppermint leaf, nettle, cranberry, marigold petals)

So every sip is not only an experience in itself, but also a gesture of generosity towards our mission.
